

INVISIBLE PATTERNS TECHNICAL TIPS

MIRRORS AND HEADLIGHTS



All Invisible Patterns Headlamp templates have been designed to cover as much of the lens as possible whilst maintaining an outer perimeter for heat dissipation.

On 99% of headlamps it is always advisable to start from the edge nearest the centre of the vehicle and work out and around towards the fender.

Some tension may need to be applied for excess curves and occasionally some trimming off of excess may be required once part fully fitted.

Always try to allow at least 5mm from the edge of the lamp to allow for heat dissipation, this is especially critical on Hi-intensity lamps.



All Invisible Patterns Mirror templates, have been designed to offer maximum area coverage whilst maintaining ease of fitment for the installer.

On the more contoured mirrors we recommend that you affix the edge nearest the door and work out 1" at a time towards the outer edge, constantly tensioning material to maintain shape and adhesion.

Ensure that fingers and film are suitably covered with solution to avoid any fingerprints in adhesive. Also avoid over-stretching as this may cause adhesive to become unstable and leave silvering marks.
